FIVE FUN, EVERYDAY ACTIVITIES FOR TODDLER SPEECH AND LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT

PRETEND COOKING

Cook your child's favorite meals with fake utensils. Work on steps and sequencing with this activity. "First we pour. Then we mix. Last we eat."

PLAYIING WITH DOLLS

Enacting routines with dolls is an important pretend play milestone. Have your child take the doll to different routines. Have your child give the doll fake food, a fake bath, and even a fake bedtime routine.

PLAYING DOCTOR

Work on turn-taking, with you and your child taking turns being the doctor and the patient. Teach your child greetings, like "hi" and "how are you" as well as appropriate replies.

PLAY - DOH

Play-Doh is a great way to work on prepositions. E.g. – "the pink one goes on the mat", "it fell under the table" or "the red goes next to the blue"

DRAWING AND COLORING

You can work on adjectives / description words with art. For example

- "Oh that sun is hot, round, and bright."
