HOW TO READ TO YOUR CHILD TO MAXIMIZE LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT

ASK WH-QUESTIONS EVERYDAY

What... is the girl doing?
Who... is the girl talking to?
Where... is the girl going?
Why is the girl feeling so sad?
When... are they going back?

POINT OUT NEW WORDS

For younger children, point to the picture with the word multiple times.
For older children, write the word down in a "word notebook."

READ THE SAME BOOK MULTIPLE TIMES

Try to stick to one book a week
Read before naptime, before dinner, or whenever your child wants

STORY RETELL

Once you have read the book to your child several times, have them tell you the story, gently correcting vocabulary and grammar as you listen.
